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Tour Planner

The tour planner is an important tool
for planning and creating tours

It enables foresters to plan a tour
related to:

- a certain target group (e.g. preschool, adults, seniors, people with special needs),
- time of the day
- time schedule
- season
- landscape
- messages to be brought across

The tour planner contains 117 activities.

Additionally, tours can be imported and
exported and by this means exchanged
with other foresters.



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
